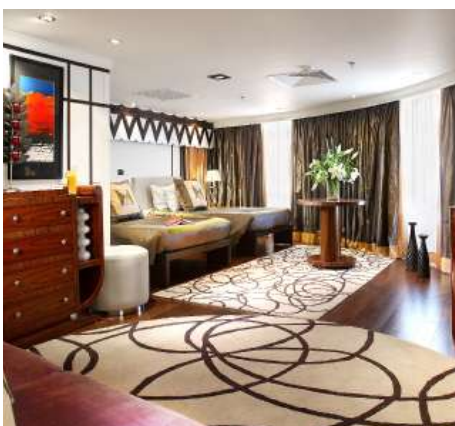
All cabins and suites are fully air-conditioned with individual control, and have Nile view plus private

Facilities

The Sanctuary Sun Boat IV has an upper sun deck with swimming pool, a shaded deck and a lounge bar. The restaurant is spacious and seats 85. In addition, there is a library and games room with computer and internet access.

Along with a gymnasium and a massage room, there is also a gift shop and laundry services. For guests wishing to relax there is room service.

On board payments
